India is not untouched with the influence of urbanisation and globalisation and at the same time, awareness and purchasing power of the consumers have significantly increased. Thus the demand for various value added, convenient and safe sheep and goat products has augmented especially in the urban area. It is the time to shift our focus from primary production of small ruminants to further processing of their produce. Food safety while processing into secondary products should properly be addressed to make them globally competitive.

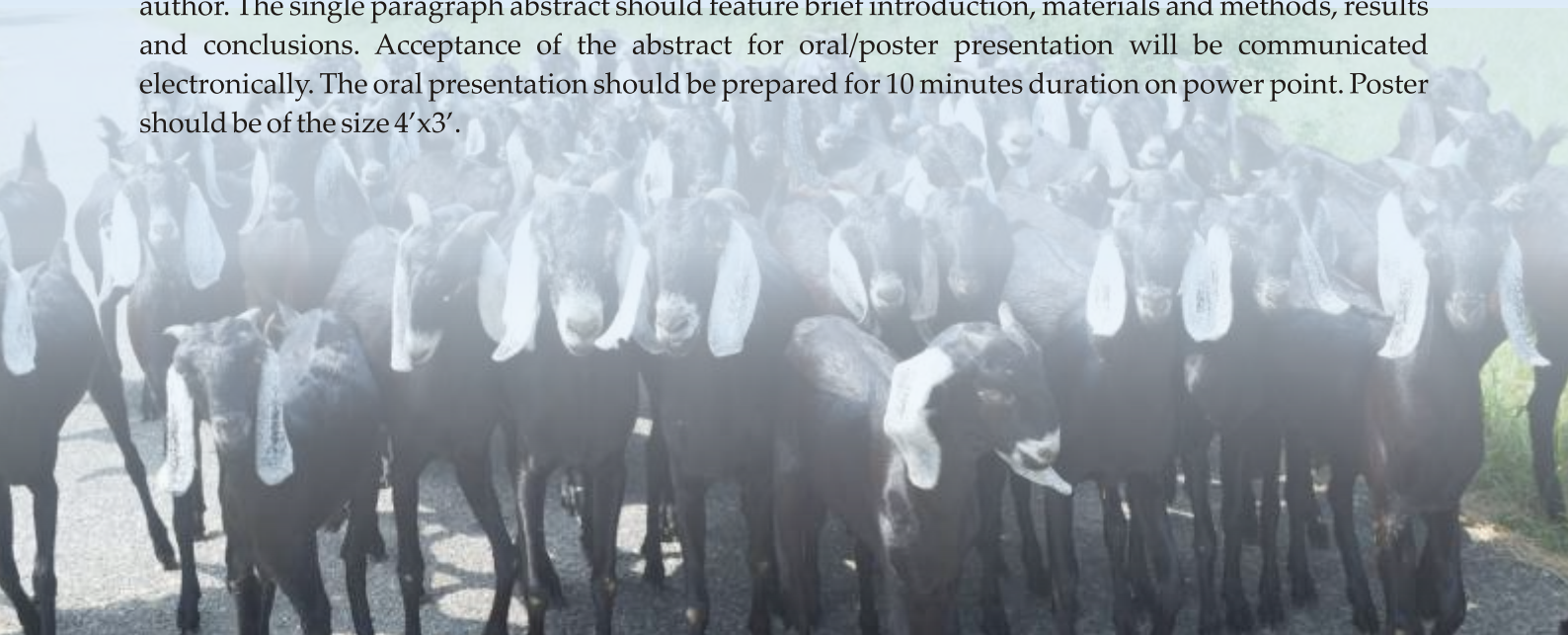

The title of the abstract should be followed by the name of the presenting and corresponding authors with complete postal address and E-mail ID of presenting author. The single paragraph abstract should feature brief introduction, materials and methods, results and conclusions. Acceptance of the abstract for oral/poster presentation will be communicated electronically. The oral presentation should be prepared for 10 minutes duration on power point. Poster should be of the size 4'x3'.
